

Rules for media accreditation

1. Accreditation of media representatives and bloggers is carried out on the basis of an application filed through the website of the Moscow Jewish Film Festival <https://mjff.ru/accreditation>.
2. Media representatives and bloggers can apply for accreditation.
3. Accreditation gives the right to free attendance of the festival with the opportunity to take seats reserved for accredited persons, as well as free ones, if available.
4. For bloggers (authors and owners of their own content projects with a single thematic concept), it is necessary to have a similar blog topic (cinema, culture, lifestyle, Jewish culture), as well as having at least 10 thousand subscribers on the target (main) account on the network on Instagram, Facebook or Vkontakte and 5 thousand subscribers in the channel in Telegram.
5. The number of persons accredited from one organization or blog is limited to:
 - For print media - up to 3 people;
 - For online media - up to 2 people;
 - For bloggers - 1 person;
 - Possible number of film crew members for TV channels is considered individually.
6. Media accreditation is carried out on the basis of:
 - Publications of the announcement material about the festival of the current year, or
 - If there is published material about the festival in previous years;
 - Official guarantee letter, certified by the media manager, with the release date and format of the post-material (attached to the application).
7. Accreditation of bloggers is carried out on the basis of an announcement about a festival posted on a blog and having a permanent address (url).
8. For accreditation, a photo of 3x4 cm in JPEG, JPG, PNG format is required, the file name must contain the last name and the first letter of the name according to the pattern PETRO-V_A.JPG, the file size should not exceed 3 MB.
9. **Applications are accepted until June 20, 2019.**
10. Accredited to the festival, media representatives and bloggers will receive a letter confirming accreditation by June 20.
11. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to refuse a media representative or blogger to provide accreditation without giving reasons.
12. Please note that the press service of the festival considers applications only from media and bloggers who meet the above criteria and provides free accreditations only to journalists and bloggers. Tickets for shows within the festival program can be purchased on the official website.
13. To obtain an accreditation badge, you must have a passport or other document confirming your identity and / or a journalistic certificate.
14. Accreditations will be handed out in the October Cinema Center (New Arbat, 24).
15. The Accreditation Service of the 5th MJFF works from June 21 to June 30, 2019.
