

Privacy Policy

INTRODUCTION AND GENERAL TERMS

The policy for the processing of personal data (hereinafter - the Policy or Privacy Policy) in accordance with Federal Law of July 27, 2006. No. 152-FL "On Personal Data" (hereinafter - FL-152).

This policy determines the procedure for the provision of personal data and measures to ensure the security of personal data of the site owner (hereinafter referred to as the Moscow Jewish Film Festival or Operator).

This corresponds to the principle of protection of privacy, personal and family life.

If you do not agree to the terms of our Privacy Policy, do not use the site mjff.ru!

This Policy contains the following information:

- the purpose of personal data processing;
- a list of personal data;
- the name or surname; name, address and the address of the person processing personal data on behalf of the operator;
- a list of actions with personal data;
- the period of validity of personal data owner consent;
- information on how to withdraw your consent to the processing of personal data.

The basic concepts used in this privacy guarantee are:

Personal data - any information related to a directly or indirectly determined or determining individual (personal data owner);

Operator - a state body, municipal body, legal or private person, independently or jointly with other persons organizing and (or) processing personal data, as well as determining the purposes of personal data processing, the composition of personal data to be processed, actions (operations) performed with personal data;

Personal data processing is any action (operation) or a set of actions (operations) that allows using automation tools or without using data, including collecting, recording, organizing, accumulating, storing, specializing (updating, changing), extracting, using, transferring (distributing, provision, access), depersonalization, blocking, deletion, destruction of personal data;

METHODS AND TERMS OF PROCESSING PERSONAL INFORMATION

Processing of user's personal data is carried out without time limit, in any legal way, including the information systems of personal data using automation tools or without the use of such tools.

Personal data of the User may be transferred to the authorized bodies of state power of the Russian Federation only on the grounds and in the manner established by the legislation of the Russian Federation.

In case of loss or disclosure of personal data, the Site Administration informs the User about the loss or disclosure of personal data.

The site administration takes the necessary organizational and technical measures to protect the User's personal information from unlawful or accidental access, destruction, alteration, blocking, copying, distribution, as well as from other illegal actions of third parties.

The site administration together with the User takes all necessary measures to prevent losses or other negative consequences caused by the loss or disclosure of the personal data of the User.

OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES

The user must:

- Provide information about personal data necessary to use the Site.

- Update, supplement the provided information about personal data in case of change of this information.
The site administration is obliged to:
- Use the information obtained solely for the purposes specified.
- To ensure the storage of confidential information in secret, not to disclose without the prior written permission of the User, and not to sell, exchange, publish, or disclose in any other possible way the transferred personal data of the User, except p. 5.2. and 5.3. this Privacy Policy.
- Take precautions to protect the confidentiality of the personal data of the User in accordance with the procedure normally used to protect this kind of information in the existing business turnover.
- Block personal data related to the relevant User from the moment of the request or request of the User or his legal representative or authorized body for the protection of the rights of personal data subjects for the period of verification, in case of unreliable personal data or illegal actions.

RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARTIES

The site administration, which has not fulfilled its obligations, is liable for losses incurred by the User in connection with the unlawful use of personal data, in accordance with the legislation of the Russian Federation, except as otherwise provided for in p. 5.2., 5.3. and 7.2. this Privacy Policy.

In case of loss or disclosure of Confidential Information, the Site Administration is not responsible if this confidential information:

- became public domain before its loss or disclosure.
- was received from a third party before it was received by the Site Administration.
- was disclosed with the consent of the User.

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Before filing a lawsuit in disputes arising from the relationship between the Site User and the Site Administration, it is obligatory to file a claim (a written proposal for a voluntary settlement of the dispute).

The claim recipient notifies the claimant in writing of the results of the consideration of the claim.

If the agreement is not reached, the dispute will be referred to the judicial authority in accordance with the current legislation of the Russian Federation.

The current legislation of the Russian Federation applies to this Privacy Policy and the relationship between the User and the Site Administration.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

The site administration has the right to make changes to this Privacy Policy without the consent of the User.

- A new Privacy Policy takes effect from the moment it is posted on the Website, unless otherwise provided by the new one
